STUDENT RECORDS

Records are maintained for students by instructors, academic advisors, Registrar's Office, Financial Aid Office, and Testing Center. These records are available for review and challenge of content by each student. Contact the Office of the Registrar at (318) 670-6229 for additional information.

STUDENT PHOTO IDs

Student ID cards **MUST** be taken during the registration process. You must have a valid SUSLA photo ID in order to receive financial aid checks, buy books at the bookstore with financial aid, check out materials from the University Library, use campus computer centers or attend University functions such as athletic events. If you are a new student (or do not have a new style SUSLA ID), you will need to have your stamped paid fee sheet and at least one other form of photo identification. If you are a returning student, you will need to have your student ID (new style) from a prior semester and your stamped paid fee sheet. **Students who do not take or reactivate their Student ID prior to the 14th day of class will be charged a \$10 late fee for new IDs. A replacement fee of \$10 will be charged for a lost, stolen or damaged card.**

VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND PARKING FEES

All students driving a vehicle on campus are required to register their vehicle and pay a parking fee of \$10.00. The permit is valid for one academic year. You must have a stamped paid fee sheet, vehicle license number, proof of insurance and a valid driver's license to receive your parking permit.

VETERANS AFFAIRS (VA) STUDENTS

- Each veteran, who is qualified as a GI Bill recipient, spouse or child of a deceased or disabled veteran should apply to the nearest Veterans Affairs Office for a **Certificate of Eligibility**. You can also apply online at <http://www.gibill.va.gov>.
- Application should be made prior to registration.
- **Certificate of Eligibility** can be forwarded to the Registrar's Office for authenticating and processing.
- **All Transfer Students** must fill out a Form 22-1995.
- **VA students must** come to the Financial Aid Office to provide the payment letter (1606 & 1607)
- **VA Data Forms** (can be picked up in the Registrar's office) must be completed for each semester the student attends the University. Along with a paid receipt and completed VA Data form the student must return this information to the Registrar's office for processing in order to receive benefits.

WITHDRAWAL

Students must officially drop a course or withdraw by deadline date on academic calendar from the University in order to receive "W" grades. Cessation of attendance DOES NOT constitute withdrawal and may result in the student receiving a failing grade in the course and may affect financial aid eligibility. A student may request a copy of refund procedures from the Registrar's Office.

ONLINE INFORMATION

Student requirements for taking online courses:

It is the student's responsibility to meet with the instructor the first week of classes to obtain specific course instructions to be successful.

ONLINE (Internet Delivered) COURSES

Student's must:

- Be disciplined and have good time management skills to ensure completion of assignments and tests as scheduled.
- Have access to a functioning computer for communication, accessing assignments, grades and tests.
- Have a means to access the internet.
- Obtain username/password for student computer lab and Blackboard access.

PLACEMENT TESTING

Placement tests are designed to determine levels of proficiency in the basic skills of reading, writing and mathematics. Students who demonstrate a need for basic skill development will be advised to take or enroll in the appropriate developmental study course or courses. This service is designed to make sure you are placed in classes where you can be successful.

Students who require testing must take the placement test before they can register.

FEES AND EXPENSES

(Subject to Change – Revised Fall 2009)

Application Fees

There is a nonrefundable \$5.00 fee for new admission applications. There is a nonrefundable \$15.00 application fee for international students.

Louisiana Resident Students

A general registration fee of \$1,247 per regular semester and \$440 for the summer term is charged to all full-time Louisiana resident students.

Out-of-State Residents

An out-of-state resident fee of \$565 per regular semester and \$276 for the summer session in addition to the general registration fee will be charged for all non-resident students.

Add/Drop Courses

There is a \$2.00 fee for each add or drop course transaction beginning February 5, 2010.

Technology Fee

A state-mandated technology fee is included in the Fee Schedule. The purpose of this fee is to meet the growing technological needs of the students. The amount of the fee is based on the number of credit hours pursued.

Fee exemption for persons 55 and older

Persons 55 years or older qualify for full-paid tuition-free for each semester enrolled.

Summary of Fees and Expenses

Included in the \$1,247 full-time (12 hours) tuition and fees per semester are (1) general registration, (2) technology fees, and (3) student assessments: student activities, lyceum, insurance, class dues, ID card, student publications, athletics, social activities, student government, etc.

Late Registration Fee

A late registration charge of \$6.00 is imposed on students on or after the date classes begin in any semester.

Transcript Fee

A fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each transcript requested from the University.

SUSLA STUDENT USERNAMES COMPUTER ACCESS EMAIL BLACKBOARD & BANNER ACCOUNTS

Student Usernames and Password

Your SUSLA Username is USUALLY your first initial, last name, and the last four digits of your Social Security Number- no spaces, no dashes, or other punctuation. The creation of your UserName is based on the way your name is spelled in Banner. Accounts for new students are created upon completion of the payment process at the beginning of each semester. Normally your initial password is your Social Security Number- no dashes or spaces.

Computer Labs and Computer Access

SUSLA Students have access to over 250 computers in more than a dozen Computer Labs at the Martin Luther King Drive location, the Metro Center, and the Aerospace Technology Center. UserNames and passwords are required to log on to the computers. To log on to a computer in one of the labs, type your UserName and password in the specified boxes. Type "SUSLA" in the third box titled Log on to." It is VERY IMPORTANT that you log off your account when you leave the computer. Your computer access account is allowed a *limited* amount of printing each semester. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY that no one else has access to your account or password. SUSLA Student Email

Your SUSLA Student Email account gives you access to Southern University at Shreveport 's email system through the internet. To access your mailbox, click the "Campus Email" link on the main SUSLA web page (www.susla.edu) or from the Information Technology pulldown menu on any page. If a dialog box with two windows come up, enter your full SUSLA email address (UserName@susla.edu) in the User box and enter your password in the Password box. Click "OK" to access your Mailbox. If a dialog box with *three* windows comes up, enter your UserName in the User box and enter your password in the Password box, then enter "SUSLA" in the Domain box. SUSLA Blackboard Learning System

To access Blackboard, browse to <http://www.susla.edu>. Click on the "Blackboard Learning System" icon on the next screen or click on one of the "Blackboard" links in the pulldown menu. Click on "Login to Blackboard" On the next screen, click on the "Login" Button. A dialog box will appear. Type your Username and your password then click the next "Login" button. Your courses should be available within 24 hours of completing the entire registration and payment process. Your courses will be listed on the right-hand side of the welcome screen in the box titled "My Courses". Not all SUSLA courses have an associated Blackboard component. Banner Account and User ID

Your Banner Student Information System account allows you to register for classes, check your grades, and print unofficial transcripts. Your Banner User ID differs from your Student UserName. Your Banner User ID is your full Social Security Number with no dashes or spaces. Instead of a password, Banner requires a Personal Identification Number (PIN). The PIN is exactly six characters long. To log on to Banner, go to www.susla.edu and click on the Banner Web Services Icon. Click the first item on the menu, "enter Secure Area."

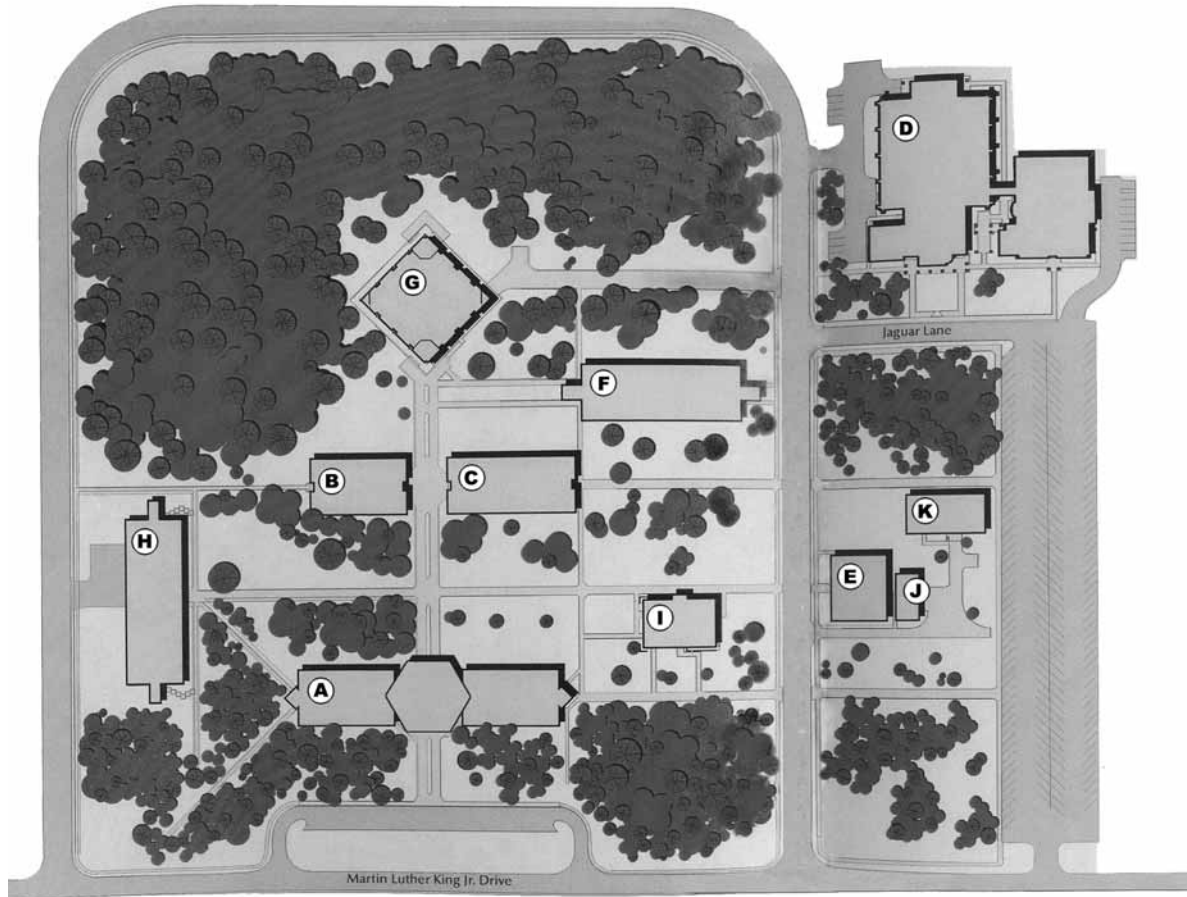
